1	Marking guide	Ending with a set sentence rewards planning: the whole story must earn that final line. Look for a clear build up, a believable discovery, and characters whose reactions feel real. The best answers leave a little mystery without leaving confusion.
2	Marking guide	Reward atmosphere over event: sounds, textures, weather and light, precise vocabulary, and contrast with the remembered summer. Strong answers control sentence length for effect, letting short sentences land like cold gusts.
3	Marking guide	A speech should sound spoken: direct address, rhetorical questions, rule of three, and a memorable closing line. Look for a clear proposal, two or three developed reasons, and an answer to a likely objection.
4	Marking guide	A diary rewards voice and honesty: first person, past tense, feelings alongside events. The best answers make the small good thing feel genuinely earned and reflect on why it mattered more than the disasters.
