Q	Answer	How to get it
1	B	In each step the first letter moves forwards 2 and the second letter moves forwards 2. So the next pair is NS.
2	E	In each step the first letter moves backwards 2 and the second letter moves forwards 3. So the next pair is LS.
3	C	In each step the first letter moves forwards 3 and the second letter moves backwards 3. So the next pair is NM.
4	D	In each step the first letter moves forwards 1 and the second letter moves forwards 2. So the next pair is RL.
5	A	In each step the first letter moves backwards 3 and the second letter moves backwards 1. So the next pair is JM.
6	B	In each step the first letter moves forwards 4 and the second letter moves forwards 4. So the next pair is UB.
7	C	Every letter moves 2 places forwards through the alphabet, so MATCH becomes OCVEJ.
8	E	Every letter moves 3 places forwards through the alphabet, so SCORE becomes VFRUH.
9	D	Each letter of NET moves the same number of places to make RIX. Move each letter of FEX 4 places backwards to get BAT.
10	A	Every letter moves 2 places backwards through the alphabet, so PRIZE becomes NPGXC.
11	A	Every letter moves 5 places forwards through the alphabet, so TRACK becomes YWFHP.
12	E	Each letter of GOAL moves the same number of places to make MUGR. Move each letter of ZKGS 6 places backwards to get TEAM.
13	D	The word LAMP is hidden in "small amphibian".
14	C	The word DENT is hidden in "garden tools".
15	B	The word RUST is hidden in "walrus tusk".
16	D	The word SOAP is hidden in "also applauded".
17	A	The word TIDE is hidden in "Eight identical".
18	B	The word GRIN is hidden in "big rink".
19	C	Attempt and try mean almost the same thing.
20	E	Spotless and clean mean almost the same thing.
21	D	Wander and roam mean almost the same thing.
22	A	Valiant and brave mean almost the same thing.
23	E	Scarce and rare mean almost the same thing.
24	B	Jubilant and delighted mean almost the same thing.

25	C	The others are dances. A compass shows direction.
26	E	The others are baby birds. A sapling is a young tree.
27	C	The others are punctuation marks. A veranda is part of a house.
