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Q	Answer	How to get it
1	C	In each step the first letter moves forwards 3 and the second letter moves backwards 3. So the next pair is PK.
2	D	In each step the first letter moves forwards 2 and the second letter moves forwards 2. So the next pair is NR.
3	B	In each step the first letter moves backwards 3 and the second letter moves forwards 3. So the next pair is EO.
4	E	In each step the first letter moves forwards 1 and the second letter moves forwards 2. So the next pair is LT.
5	A	In each step the first letter moves backwards 2 and the second letter moves forwards 2. So the next pair is RJ.
6	A	In each step the first letter moves forwards 5 and the second letter moves backwards 1. So the next pair is WN.
7	B	Every letter moves 2 places forwards through the alphabet, so CAKE becomes ECMG.
8	C	Every letter moves 4 places forwards through the alphabet, so TOAST becomes XSEWX.
9	E	Each letter of JAM moves the same number of places to make MDP. Move each letter of SLH 3 places backwards to get PIE.
10	D	Every letter moves 2 places backwards through the alphabet, so SUGAR becomes QSEYP.
11	E	Every letter moves 5 places forwards through the alphabet, so SALAD becomes XFQFI.
12	B	Each letter of RICE moves the same number of places to make YPJL. Move each letter of ZVBW 7 places backwards to get SOUP.
13	C	The word CHAT is hidden in "much attention".
14	A	The word SEAT is hidden in "sea turtle".
15	D	The word HERO is hidden in "father owns".
16	D	The word IDEA is hidden in "said each".
17	A	The word GONE is hidden in "cargo nets".
18	E	The word ECHO is hidden in "the choir".
19	B	Halt and stop mean almost the same thing.
20	C	Plentiful and abundant mean almost the same thing.
21	A	Feeble and weak mean almost the same thing.
22	C	Dwell and live mean almost the same thing.
23	E	Summit and peak mean almost the same thing.
24	B	Anxious and worried mean almost the same thing.
25	D	The others are workshop tools. A saucepan belongs in a kitchen.

26	B	The others are seasonings. A melody is part of music.
27	A	The others travel on roads or rails. A canoe travels on water.
28	E	The others are winds. Drizzle is light rain.
29	D	The others are fish. A wren is a bird.
30	C	The others are types of wood. Marble is stone.
31	E	Each number is double the one before. The next number is 112.
32	A	Each number is the one before divided by 5. The next number is 2.
33	B	The gaps grow by one each time. The next number is 16.
34	C	Double the last number and add 1. The next number is 111.
35	D	They are the cube numbers 1, 2, 3, 4 cubed, so next is 5 cubed. The next number is 125.
36	A	Each number is 15 less than the one before. The next number is 80.
