Answer sheet with explanations

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Q	Answer	How to get it
1	E	In each step the first letter moves forwards 3 and the second letter moves forwards 3. So the next pair is OB.
2	B	In each step the first letter moves backwards 2 and the second letter moves forwards 2. So the next pair is PI.
3	C	In each step the first letter moves forwards 2 and the second letter moves backwards 3. So the next pair is QJ.
4	A	In each step the first letter moves forwards 1 and the second letter moves forwards 4. So the next pair is QU.
5	D	In each step the first letter moves backwards 4 and the second letter moves forwards 2. So the next pair is DS.
6	A	In each step the first letter moves forwards 2 and the second letter moves backwards 2. So the next pair is NQ.
7	E	Every letter moves 2 places forwards through the alphabet, so GOAT becomes IQCV.
8	B	Every letter moves 3 places forwards through the alphabet, so LLAMA becomes OODPD.
9	D	Each letter of HEN moves the same number of places to make LIR. Move each letter of JSB 4 places backwards to get FOX.
10	C	Every letter moves 2 places backwards through the alphabet, so DUCKS becomes BSAIQ.
11	B	Every letter moves 5 places forwards through the alphabet, so ZEBRA becomes EJGWF.
12	A	Each letter of BULL moves the same number of places to make IBSS. Move each letter of JHSM 7 places backwards to get CALF.
13	D	The word RAIN is hidden in "zebra instead".
14	E	The word TENT is hidden in "kitten toys".
15	C	The word SNOW is hidden in "trains now".
16	E	The word CORN is hidden in "picnic or".
17	A	The word BEAR is hidden in "superb earrings".
18	B	The word MICE is hidden in "dynamic entry".
19	D	Vacant and empty mean almost the same thing.
20	C	Aroma and scent mean almost the same thing.
21	E	Hasty and hurried mean almost the same thing.
22	D	Miserable and unhappy mean almost the same thing.
23	C	Sturdy and strong mean almost the same thing.
24	A	Conceal and hide mean almost the same thing.
25	B	The others are musical instruments. A lantern gives light.

26	E	The others are tropical fruits. A biscuit is baked.
27	C	The others are violent storms. A meadow is a field.
28	B	The others are boats. A sketch is a drawing.
29	A	The others are plants. A magnet attracts metal.
30	D	The others are homes. A saddle sits on a horse.
31	B	Each number is three times the one before. The next number is 162.
32	A	Each number is the one before divided by 3. The next number is 9.
33	C	The gaps grow by one each time. The next number is 20.
34	D	Double the last number and take away 1. The next number is 113.
35	E	They are the square numbers 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 squared, so next is 7 squared. The next number is 49.
36	D	Each number is 11 less than the one before. The next number is 53.
