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Q	Answer	How to get it
1	B	In each step the first letter moves forwards 2 and the second letter moves forwards 2. So the next pair is JV.
2	A	In each step the first letter moves backwards 3 and the second letter moves forwards 3. So the next pair is JQ.
3	E	In each step the first letter moves forwards 3 and the second letter moves backwards 1. So the next pair is VN.
4	C	In each step the first letter moves forwards 2 and the second letter moves forwards 3. So the next pair is MT.
5	D	In each step the first letter moves backwards 2 and the second letter moves backwards 2. So the next pair is OE.
6	A	In each step the first letter moves forwards 5 and the second letter moves forwards 1. So the next pair is UX.
7	C	Every letter moves 2 places forwards through the alphabet, so SCARF becomes UECTH.
8	E	Every letter moves 3 places forwards through the alphabet, so CLOAK becomes FORDN.
9	B	Each letter of HAT moves the same number of places to make LEX. Move each letter of XMI 4 places backwards to get TIE.
10	D	Every letter moves 2 places backwards through the alphabet, so SOCKS becomes QMAIQ.
11	B	Every letter moves 5 places forwards through the alphabet, so APRON becomes FUWTS.
12	A	Each letter of BELT moves the same number of places to make HKRZ. Move each letter of BKYZ 6 places backwards to get VEST.
13	D	The word HORN is hidden in "each ornament".
14	C	The word GATE is hidden in "dog ate".
15	E	The word NOSE is hidden in "piano set".
16	E	The word DEAL is hidden in "Hide all".
17	D	The word RICH is hidden in "fabric hangs".
18	A	The word TALE is hidden in "hospital entrance".
19	C	Ancient and old mean almost the same thing.
20	B	Collide and crash mean almost the same thing.
21	B	Generous and kind mean almost the same thing.
22	C	Murmur and whisper mean almost the same thing.
23	E	Descend and fall mean almost the same thing.
24	D	Genuine and real mean almost the same thing.
25	A	The others are root vegetables. A pillow is bedding.

26	A	The others are colours. An anchor holds a ship.
27	B	The others are deer. A gutter is part of a roof.
28	D	The others are board or table games. Jogging is exercise.
