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Q	Answer	How to get it
1	B	In each step the first letter moves forwards 2 and the second letter moves backwards 2. So the next pair is LK.
2	C	In each step the first letter moves forwards 3 and the second letter moves forwards 3. So the next pair is TO.
3	D	In each step the first letter moves backwards 3 and the second letter moves forwards 2. So the next pair is IN.
4	A	In each step the first letter moves forwards 2 and the second letter moves forwards 1. So the next pair is SS.
5	E	In each step the first letter moves backwards 1 and the second letter moves forwards 3. So the next pair is UV.
6	C	In each step the first letter moves forwards 4 and the second letter moves backwards 4. So the next pair is SG.
7	B	Every letter moves 2 places forwards through the alphabet, so TRACK becomes VTCEM.
8	A	Every letter moves 3 places forwards through the alphabet, so PILOT becomes SLORW.
9	D	Each letter of BUS moves the same number of places to make FYW. Move each letter of GEF 4 places backwards to get CAB.
10	E	Every letter moves 2 places backwards through the alphabet, so WHARF becomes UFYPD.
11	A	Every letter moves 5 places forwards through the alphabet, so BRAKE becomes GWFPJ.
12	C	Each letter of ROAD moves the same number of places to make YVHK. Move each letter of SHUL 7 places backwards to get LANE.
13	D	The word SPIN is hidden in "wasp inside".
14	B	The word MASK is hidden in "cinema sketch".
15	E	The word NEST is hidden in "line stops".
16	B	The word ARCH is hidden in "car chase".
17	C	The word EASE is hidden in "idea seemed".
18	E	The word ONCE is hidden in "Iron certainly".
19	D	Locate and find mean almost the same thing.
20	A	Fragile and delicate mean almost the same thing.
21	C	Prohibit and forbid mean almost the same thing.
22	A	Glisten and sparkle mean almost the same thing.
23	B	Reply and answer mean almost the same thing.
24	E	Furious and livid mean almost the same thing.
25	D	The others are garden birds. A bridge crosses a river.

26	E	The others are rocks. Velvet is a fabric.
27	B	The others are brass instruments. A scooter is a vehicle.
28	D	The others are noble titles. A napkin is table linen.
29	A	The others are daily meals. A harvest is a gathering of crops.
30	C	The others are made of ice. A puddle is liquid water.
31	E	Each number is three times the one before. The next number is 324.
32	A	Each number is half the one before. The next number is 32.
33	B	The gaps grow by two each time: 2, 4, 6, 8, then 10. The next number is 31.
34	C	Double the last number and take away 1. The next number is 129.
35	D	Double the last number and add 1. The next number is 95.
